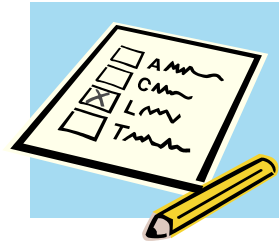
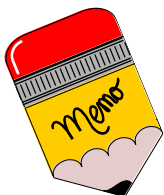

Below 50 degrees F --- do not feed
 50F - 55F --- 1-2 times per week*
 56F - 60F --- 2-3 times per week*
 61F - 68F --- once a day
 69F - 72F --- 1-2 times per day
 73F - 79F --- 3-5 times a day
 80F - 86F --- 3-4 times per day
 Above 86F --- do not feed

- feed only wheat germ (or Cheerios) between 50F - 60F.
