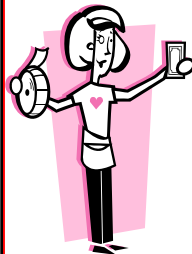

### Elusive Eragon

Additionally, creeks have some great hiding places, like around tree trunks, etc. And with each attempt, we increased the number of people helping, but that didn't seem to make much difference either.
