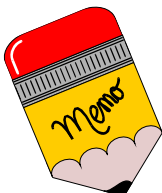

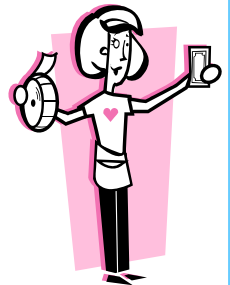

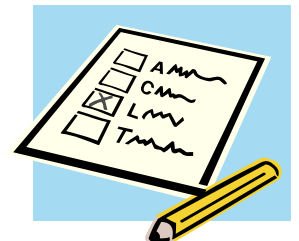


AKCA News

The May meeting will be at my home. It has been a number of years since we've hosted a meeting but, I think that is mostly because we are always renovating something. Nothing has changed, some of the floors are looking awful where we pulled up the carpeting and have not yet put down the planned ceramic tile. That will wait because we are getting ready to upgrade the filtration of the ponds. We may have to wait for nice floors but at least the koi will have nice water.

We bought our home knowing eventually there would be a pond or two in the backyard. Now there are 4 ponds. The first was the 5000 gallon koi pond which is now home for the Butterfly or Longfins including 3 Grand Champions. The larger koi pond is 15,000 gallons and is the residence of our Nishikigoi. Off the patio is a 1,500 gallon goldfish pond for fancy goldfish only. Follow the walkway to the back of the yard to find the 300 gallon quarantine pond. The ponds are of a formal style with raised walls. You'll see lots of paver stones, hardscapes are Carl's profession. Carl installed the hardscapes and I planted the gardens which by the way I am reducing to save maintenance time. I hope you enjoy yourself.
