born. After a year or so in business, someone figured out that I even sold small spray heads that could be used for a pond. Then they asked for a pump to go with it.... Then the liner..... Coastal Pond was born.

I had a 1000 gallon concrete pond in the early 80's that I had built before anyone knew anything about ponds. Bought fish and plants, which were immediately eaten, from Tricker through their catalog. Enjoyed the learning experience, even though I still didn't really know anything.

Then in 2002 we added the addition to the back of the house, and the Ipe deck, and, of course, the ponds. Since we are "The Coastal Pond," we really didn't have much choice except to really do it big and right. So we did our best without going to extremes with life support equipment and filtra-

tion. We preferred to go with plants and a simple skimmer. Then, overnight, we rescued 3 large (+/- 40 lbs of) koi. So we added the ozone system as a good way to filter the pond and learn more about it at the same time. Since then we have enjoyed our pond pets - especially at feeding time. Sitting out at the pond in the evening, listening to the streams and waterfalls, is a wonderful way to unwind.

Be sure to come to the July meeting and see these beautiful ponds and fish. The waterfall is spectacular. Bill & Lynn also have a great collection of lovely water lilies to see.
