








# Love is in the air !

They will inject some fish with Ovaprim on Saturday afternoon to see if it will encourage some koi pairings to breed. Most of us only see the aftermath and not the whole session. This should be very interesting.

There will be a pond pull (at least one) beginning about 10 A.M. and continuing until the pond is pulled. Those who want to learn how this is done...or want to help should bring waders and a change of clothes.

There are many koi from Japan — they arrived in the last shipment — for sale. The fish have already been tested for KHV (they were negative), treated for parasites and quarantined. They are ready to go home with some lucky new owners.

All Koi USA subscribers please be aware you must request the club member \$20 subscription price for AKCA club members each time you subscribe or renew your subscription to KOI USA.

PCS, the subscription service AKCA hired, groups subscribers into groups based on how they subscribed last. So, if you subscribed at the full rate of \$24.95 then the renewal invoice you receive at the end of that subscription will show that amount, even though you have joined an AKCA member club.
