The Koi Pond is 11'x16'x5' and 6,150 gallons. It was built in July 2007, by Keirin Koi. The pond and waterfall have a Polyurea spray on liner. The pergola is handcrafted of cedar. There are 31 Koi in residence from 28" to 8".
