The water quality is most important in taking care of koi and is a reflection of how each koi looks. The koi ponds themselves had good filtration, bottom drains, clear water and good systems and the fish looked healthy. There were probably 1 or 2 fish from each pond which could compete in a show. They commented that the ponds they visited were very nice and nicely landscaped. We appreciated the time they took to visit our ponds and share their perspectives with us at the Social. # "Meet Our Members" Ed & Marian Allen

### Tell us about your pond:

We joined the AKC after taking the pond tour in 2011. To make sure We could keep some fish alive, We decided to start with a tank that would eventually become the quarantine tank when We build the "dream pond" in a year or two. #1 is 500 gal, rectangular, made of stacked 4x4 pressure-treated, held together with threaded rods. 4x10x42" deep. Filter is Laguna 3200, pump 1/2 hp 22/gal/Min. Pond is on a concrete pad, indside a screen room. We



Started out With three "goldFiSH" (tWo turned out to be Koi). We have 3 long-Fin Koi, 2 local Koi, 2 comet goldFiSH, 1 calico Shubunkin.

#2 is a 150 gal stock tank, quarantine tank. Filter is rescued rectangular gravity FLOW With Foam/ Fiber and bioballs, pump 10 gal/min. Fish: Wakin goldFish, number of Fish approx. 30, 1" to 3".

#3 50 gal Stock tank, quarantine tank. Filter is in tank Fiber, pump 120 gal/Hr. Fish: Mosquito Fish, number of Fish—undetermined 5 adult, multitude of Fry

#4 12 gal Fountain concrete, Filter is in tank Fiber, pump 120 gal/Hr. Fish: Mosquito Fish.

We enjoy the AKC, Meeting people, Seeing Lots of ponds and getting More Fascinated by Koi.
